Support for International Conference Travel Expenses for the Fiscal Year 2013

For the purpose of developing the ability of graduate students to present their research achievements at academic conferences, the education program will support the expenses incurred for travel and accommodation.

QUALIFICATION: Students in Doctoral Course of Graduate School of Medical Sciences.

If any incorrect descriptions in the submitted documents were found, the student will not be entitled to apply this grant throughout the years in this school.

PRESENTATION TO BE SUPPORTED: A presentation (including a poster presentation) that the applicant will present / presented as the first author at an international conference from April 1, 2013 to March 31, 2014, and the presentation needs to meet all of the following requirements.

- (i) The applicant needs to be responsible for all expenses related to transportation and accommodation required for the conference presentation.
- (ii) The case that can implement the budget within the fiscal year 2013. In particular, please note that it's difficult to implement the budget if the conference will be held near the end of the fiscal year.
- (iii) The applicant needs to submit all required documents.

LIMITTATION OF NUMBER OF APPLICATION: Number of application is limited to one for an applicant for the fiscal year 2013.

AMMOUNT OF SUPPORT: Expenses for travel and accommodation will be supported. Amount of the scholarship is a maximum 200,000 yen. It should be economical way by using a discount fare or package tour, and also there are limitations in accordance with the Kumamoto University's stipulations. Allowance may be reduced in the case of excess amount of traveling expenses incurred.

SUPPORT CONDITION: Students supported by this program will be requested to submit a report describing the results obtained from participation in the conference. (The report form will be given separately.)

School of Medical Sciences by February 5 (Wed.), 2014.

- (ii) Publications list (Published papers and Conference presentations)
- (iii) Documents about the conference:
 - A copy of the conference program page that shows the authors and the title of your presentation. Please also provide information on the name, date, and venue of the conference, as well as the type of your presentation (poster/oral).
 - 2) A copy of your abstract
- (iv) All documents relating to expenses: The receipts of the cost of ticket, the boarding pass and others. If the application date is before the conference, the applicant needs to submit these documents as soon as the applicant returns to Kumamoto.
